  ID w/ four zeroes in front (Jane Doe
  PC# 12345, ex. Username: 000012345)
  and your TEMPORARY password is your
  date of birth followed by the FIRST
  letter of your LAST name (Jane Doe
  January 1, 2000, ex. Password:
  1012000D).
- Apply for the Commonwealth College
  Access Grant (CCAG) available for all
  high school students taking courses at
  NMC (visit www.cnmischolarship.net for
  more info) by July 1 or December 15.
