b. Liberal Arts Individual Degree Plan

Daisy Villagomez-Bier, Director of the Counseling Programs and Services, presented the revised Liberal Arts Individual Degree Plan that had been discussed at the May 12, 2003 Academic Council meeting with additional recommendations from the Counseling Programs and Services Department. Glenn Keaton suggested changing the MA111 "Survey of Math" course to MA132 "Intermediate Algebra" course under the core requirements. Ms. Villagomez-Bier's letter is attached for reference.

The Counseling Programs and Services Department is also requesting for the revised IDP to become effective Spring 2004. Ms. Eleanor Cabrera, Academic Advising Coordinator, informed the council that students already in the program would be given the option to continue with the old IDP or transfer into the new IDP.

By unanimous vote, the revised Liberal Arts Individual Degree Plan is approved.
