Teacher Candidacy Portfolio Requirements

Instructions:

You are required to develop a paper-based (binder) portfolio or an e-portfolio to assemble the Teacher Candidacy (TC) requirements listed below. If you choose an e-portfolio, you must ensure that you provide access and downloading rights to the TC Coordinator, Ms. Rosaline Cepeda (rosaline.cepeda@marians.edu). Your portfolio must include a title page with your name, and a table of contents.

1. Teacher Candidacy (TC) Admission Application

The TC admission application must be filled in, signed, and dated.

2. <u>Letters of Recommendation</u>

Obtain three (3) letters of recommendation from current or former instructors or employers (letters should not be from relatives or friends). The letters must be signed by the recommenders. Content of the letters will be evaluated based on collaboration, academic commitment and excellence, and personal conduct (i.e. integrity, honesty, initiative, resourcefulness, and responsibility).

3. Resume or Curriculum Vitae

Submit a formal document summarizing your background information related to your education, academic achievements, acquired skills, previous and present jobs, volunteer work, professional developments attended, and personal interests.

4. Statement of Purpose Essay

Attach a typewritten double-spaced essay outlining individual reasons for entering the Northern Marianas College School of Education. Include a brief autobiographical sketch (i.e., school experiences, work-related experiences, etc.); explain individual interest and commitment to this educational program. Include your future career goals and what you can offer.

5. Safety Assurance Documentation

Obtain and submit a clean **Police Clearance** from the CNMI Department of Public Safety, and a **Health Clearance** from any clinic in the CNMI, processed within the last 12 months. You may use the NMC Health Evaluation form.

6. 57 Acceptable College Course Credits (with a grade of 'C' or better)

Must complete 57 general education college course credits including EN101, EN202, MA132 (or higher); PY101, HISTORY COURSE, CO210, ED211, ED205, ED282, ED290 (formerly ED480).

7. Photo

Include a 2x2 sized photo of yourself.
