

NMC FOUNDATION ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

Friday Jan. 13, 2016 Venue: NMC Campus, Board of Regents Conference Room

- I. Call to Order—The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

V. Reports:

- a. Discussion of the upcoming annual Foundation golf tournament:
 - a. A detailed spreadsheet was presented of the offered contributions corporations and individuals. These contributions included cash and in-kind, which the Board primarily raised. The Board essentially identifies businesses they have a personal connection to, or a contact with, and then line up the donation for the director to pick up. Virtually all of the funds raised will occur before the tournament takes place and the director manages details that must be handled leading up to the day of the tournament.  - c. There was concern that expenses might be excessive so that net revenue from the event would be diminished. Discussion of how to minimize expenses, perhaps by soliciting specific in-kind contributions to offset expenses for materials or services.
- b. Report of continued work on contribution by FEMA with regard to damage sustained by typhoon last summer. Further discussion was tabled until next meeting.
