	1. The Academic Council and Program Review and Outcomes Assessment Committee (PROAC) to strengthen faculty ownership of the curriculum.
	2. Its teaching enrichment program where faculty applications for professional development include plans to teach colleagues lessons learns from their development experiences.
	3. The additional, qualified staff to strengthen the institutional research function.
	4. A thorough review of General Education Student Learning Outcomes and for curriculum mapping.
	5. Its coordination with the Public School System (PSS) on placement testing, college readiness and college credits prior to admission, a partnership that serves as a model for peer institutions.
