# DISCUSSION AND OUTLOOK

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AT 400 PM CHST...0600 UTC...THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION 02W WAS LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 5.8 DEGREES NORTH AND LONGITUDE 149.5 DEGREES EAST. 02W IS MOVING NORTH-NORTHWEST AT 2 MPH. IT IS EXPECTED TO MAINTAIN THIS GENERAL COURSE WITH AN INCREASE IN FORWARD SPEED OVER THE NEXT 24 HOURS.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS REMAIN AT 30 MPH. 02W IS FORECAST TO INTENSIFY OVER THE NEXT FEW DAYS, POSSIBLY BECOMING A TROPICAL STORM TONIGHT AND A TYPHOON SUNDAY NIGHT.

BECAUSE OF THE ANTICIPATED THREAT OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION (02W), GOVERNOR ARNOLD I. PALACIOS HAS ISSUED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS AS OF 5:00 PM.

• TYPHOON CONDITION III: SAIPAN, TINIAN, ROTA

\*TYPHOON CONDITION III: MEANS THAT DAMAGING WINDS OF 39 MPH OR MORE ARE POSSIBLE MONDAY, AND TYPHOON FORCE WINDS OF 74 MPH OR GREATER ARE POSSIBLE MONDAY NIGHT THROUGH WEDNESDAY.
